

### **SUBFRESHMAN SUPPLY LIST**

Along with general supplies such as paper, pencils, and pens, the subfreshman teachers ask that each student be prepared on the first day of school with the following supplies:

#### **GENERAL**

- one 1.5 - 3 inch three-ring binder
- 5 tab dividers with labels (for sections dedicated to English, Social Studies, Math, Science and Foreign Language)
- College-ruled loose-leaf paper (stored in binder)
- Pencil pouch
- Dark colored ink pens (blue or black only please)
- Pencils and erasers
- Colored pencils (minimum 6 different colors)
- 2 - Highlighters (of different colors, one should be yellow)
- Tiny stapler
- Scissors
- Red pen

#### **ENGLISH**

- College-ruled single subject spiral bound notebook

#### **SOCIAL STUDIES**

- Earphones or earbuds that can be plugged into a laptop (for listening to audio)

#### **MATHEMATICS**

- Graph paper (stored in binder)
- Spiral notebook (stored in binder)
- A graphing calculator (TI-84 preferred) will be required for all Uni math classes. Students who purchase a Texas Instruments calculator are requested to turn in the "TI Technology Rewards Program" points block from the calculator packaging (the department can redeem points for TI products for classroom use).
- Students in Math 1/Math 2/Math 3 will need a sturdy compass, a sturdy ruler, and a sturdy protractor ("sturdy" means they will hold up under backpack conditions). We recommend AGAINST the plastic-cased "math kits" available at some discount stores; the compass in those kits is often poorly constructed and does not work well.

#### **SCIENCE**

- National Brand Computation Notebook 43-648; 75 sheets, 4x4 quad – no substitutions; available at Illini Union Bookstore

#### **GERMAN**

Single subject notebook only for German and a red/pink, blue, and yellow highlighters

#### **JAPANESE**

- Small white board and black and blue dry-erase markers

#### **INTERRELATED ARTS**

- Sketchbook of unlined paper, spiral bound, 8" x 10" or larger. (Partially used sketchbooks OK.)
- Mechanical pencils with erasers

#### **COMPUTER LITERACY 1**

- USB flash drive ("thumb drive") with at least 32 GB capacity.

#### **PHYSICAL EDUCATION**

- Running shoes, need to be quality shoes to minimize the risk of support issues
- Shorts and t-shirt or other acceptable PE attire
- Hair ties
